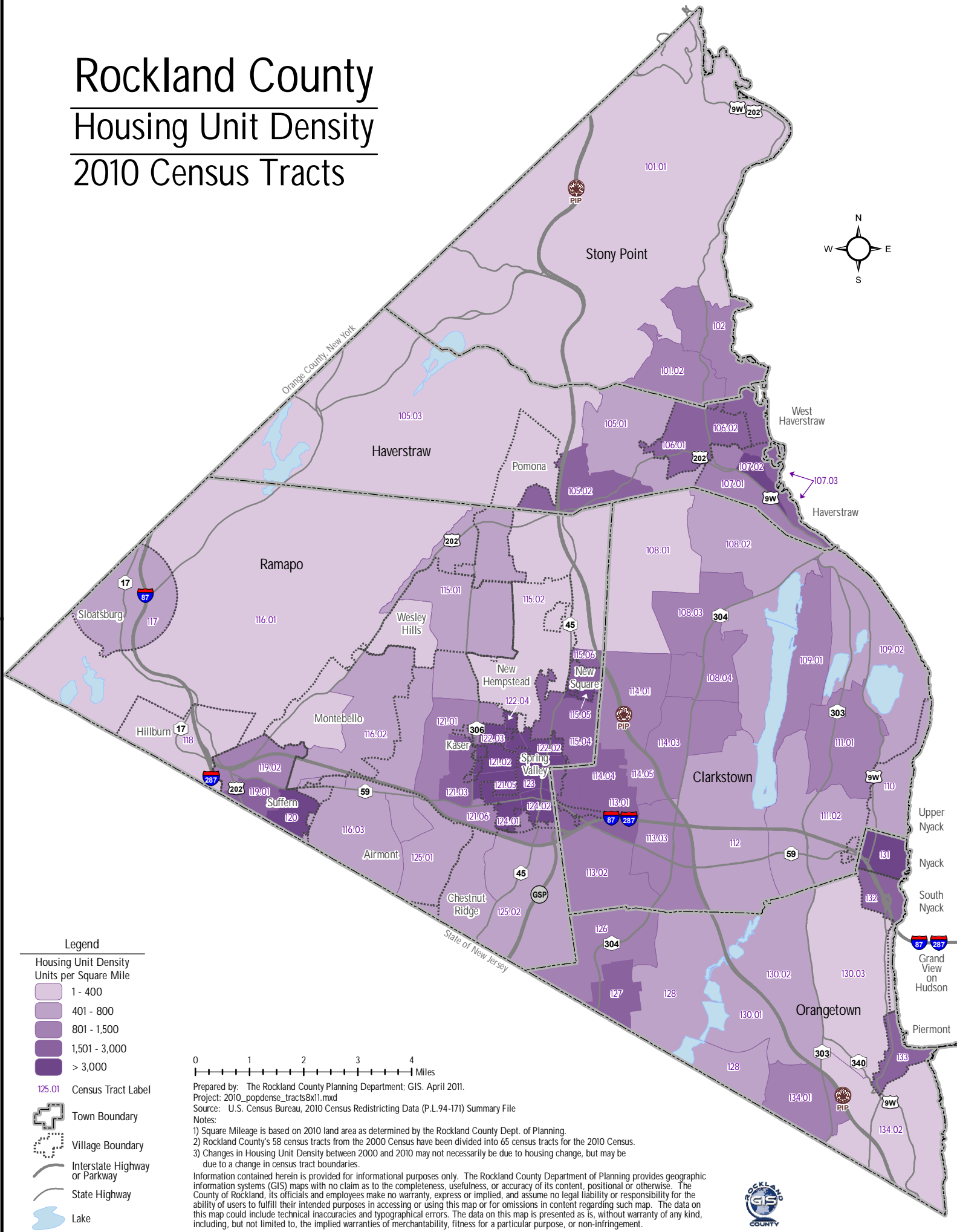


Rockland County Housing Unit Density 2010 Census Tracts

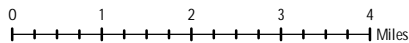
